

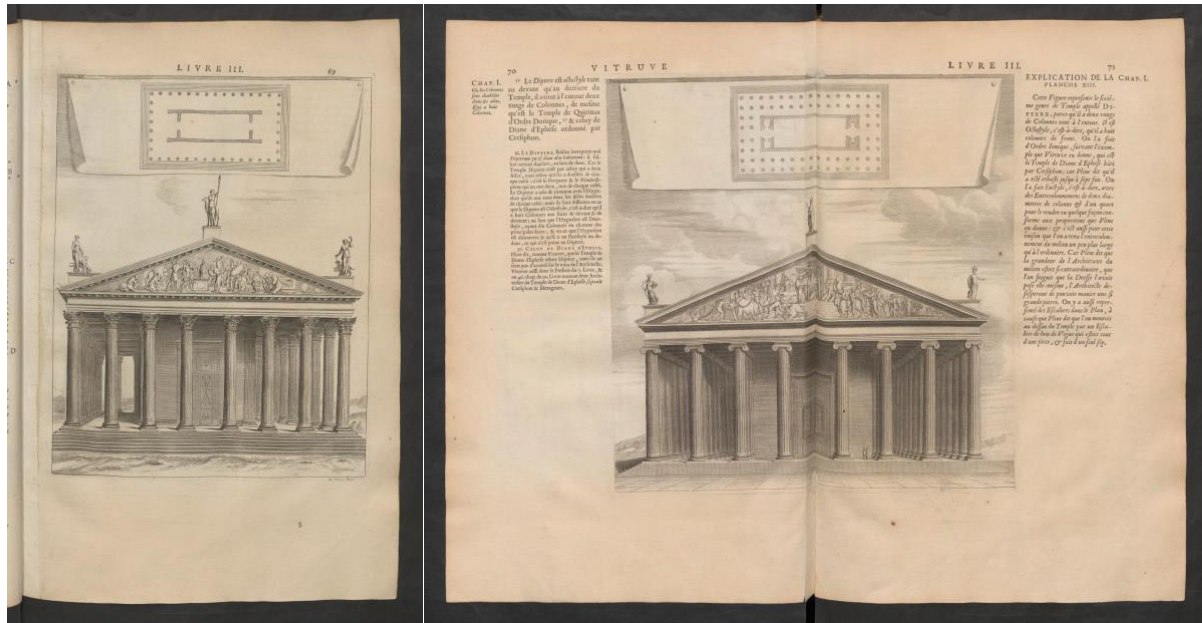
Friends with an old book

Shown here are Pages 94 and 95 of the PDF of Claude Perrault's *Les Dix Livres d'Architecture de Vitruve*. In the previous pages, it is shown how the number of columns has evolved over the years, starting with just row at the front of the building. Yet these two pages seem the most relevant as the difference between the two is most notable. On the right the temple is surrounded with only one row of columns which leaves a lot of space between them and the actual inner building. The one on the right is all the more imposing with almost a forest of columns. Furthermore, it is interesting how all the previous drawings were only on one pages and the final evolution was deemed worthy enough to be printed on a double page.
