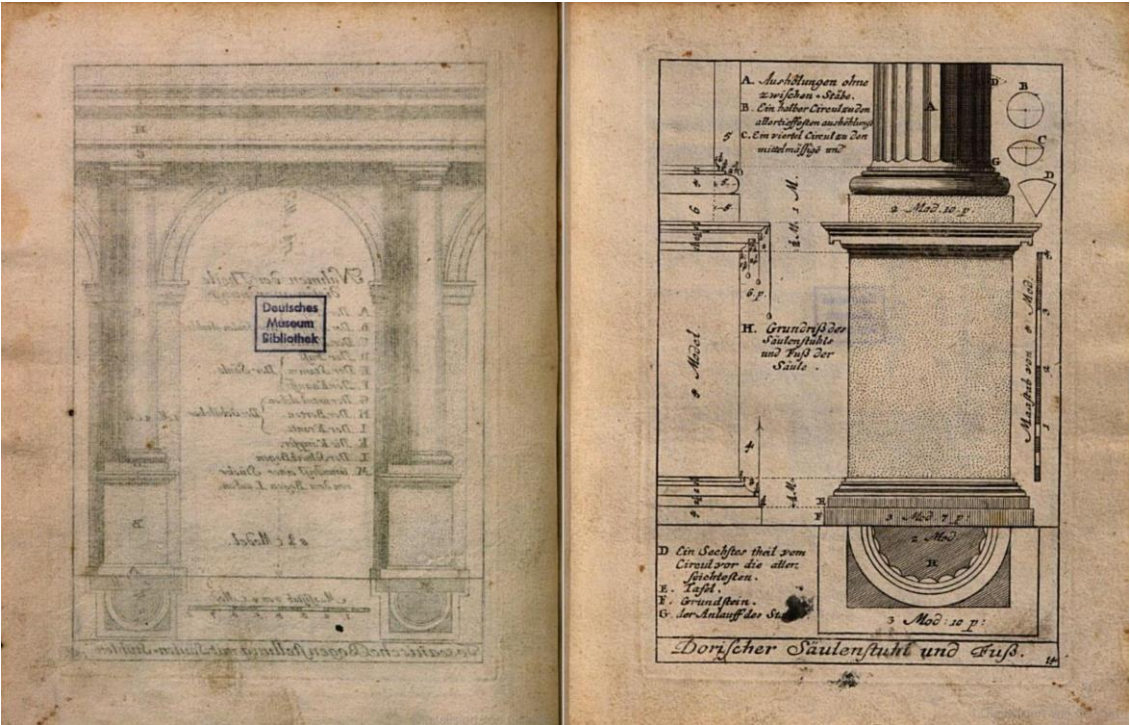
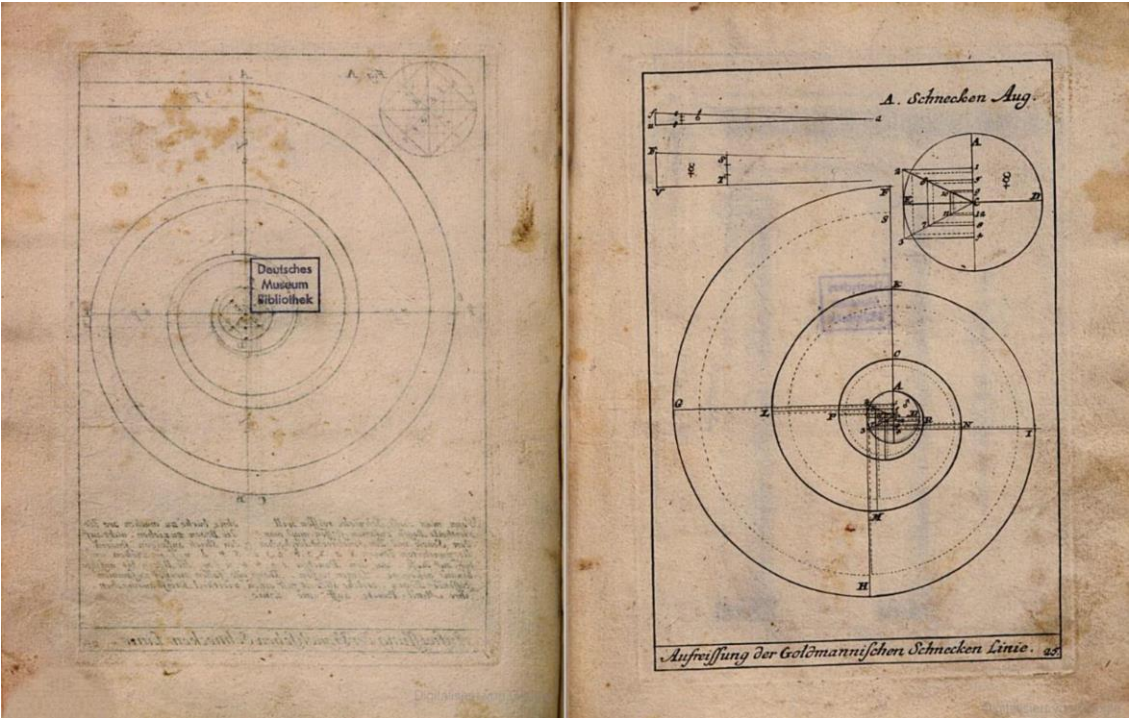


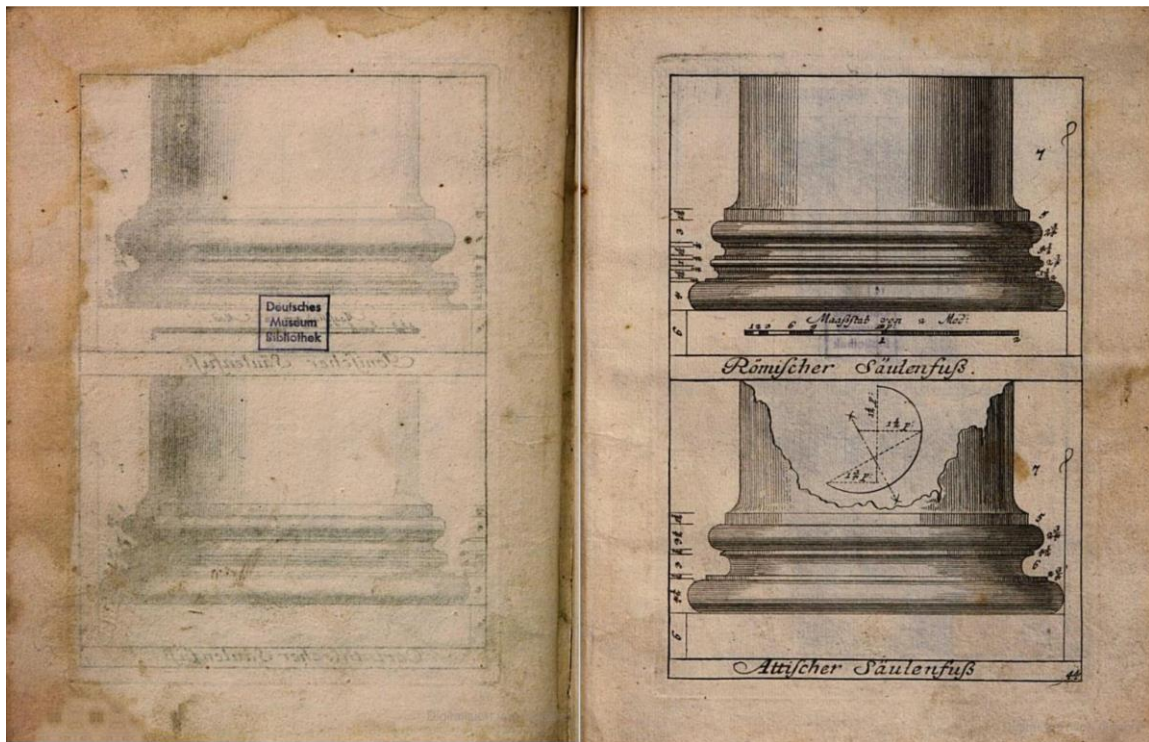
It seems that in our book the quality of the paper was not that good. The prints shine through them and therefore only one page of two could be printed on. Because of the transparency of the paper, the spreads have a very diverse appearance (unintentionally).



In this spread, the print of the site before shines through almost strong enough so that one could mistake it for an independent print.



In this example, the print, together with the print from the previous page, results in a kind of a point-symmetric appearance.



In this example, the print from the previous page is extremely similar to the print on this spread. Therefore, the reader could think that it is the imprint of the same spread.
