

### Taks 3 - Xenotheka - Jan Lang

In order to find books that are in any way related to Jean Baptiste Rondelet's *Mémoire Historique sur le Panthéon Français*, I used the following words for the search-engine Alice to look for: *Mémoire Historique*, *Pantheon - Panthéon*, *Pillars - Pillar Renovation*, *Dome*, *Neo-Classicism*, *National Monument*, *Mausoleum*. I chose architecture as the topic of conversation and the Xenotheka Library as Alice's brain. On my first attempt at using the engine to find books for a certain key word, the amount of results Alice came up with overwhelmed me, but I quickly found out about the Explore and Find Options, basically two ways of searching for a word, one is searching in a broader spectrum of the given word and the other is looking for the exact word/phrase.

Two key words seemed to be promising with their information outputs, those words were *Pantheon* and *neo-classicism*. For "neo-classicism", Alice suggested me the Book *Eighteenth Century Architecture Volume II edited by van Eck and de Jong* and for "Pantheon" Alice suggested *The Pantheon by Marder/Jones*. As far as *Eighteenth Century Architecture Volume II edited by van Eck and de Jon* is considered in relation to my book, it speaks about the main buildings and main architects of the neo-classical period of whom one is called Soufflet, the architect of the Panthéon Français, whereas the other book *The Pantheon by Marder/Jones* speaks about the whole history of the Pantheon in Rome, mentioning the Panthéon Français for comparison during the neo classical period.
